The Mayor opened the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance.

The Mayor Notified the board that he established Executive Order #1, placing the Village in a state of Emergency due to the Covid-19 pandemic. This was needed to be declared in the event we sought funding from FEMA and would allow the Mayor to impose other restrictions if necessary. The County and Town has already made their declarations.

The Mayor asked that the board members come in at their leisure to review vouchers and correspondence and we will try to have a regular meeting this month.

The only item pressing is a bond resolution for the new highway snow plow truck which notification was published. The Mayor stated that This resolution is subject to a permissive referendum pursuant to Section 36 of the Local Finance Law and Article 9 of the Village Law of the State of New York. This resolution authorizes the acquisition of a Western Star 4700 SF heavy duty truck with dump body, plow and wing at an estimated maximum cost of \$195,952, and authorizes the issuance of serial bonds of the Village of Tannersville, Greene County, New York, in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$195,952 pursuant to the Local Finance Law to finance the cost thereof.

This resolution shall take effect thirty days after adoption, unless there shall be filed with the Village Clerk a petition signed and acknowledged by the electors of the Village in number equal to at least twenty percentum of such electors in the Village, as shown on the register of elections for the previous general village election, protesting against this resolution and requesting that the matter be submitted to the electors of the Village for their approval or disapproval in the manner provided by Village Law.

Trustee McGunnigle made a motion to adopt the bond resolution subject to permissive referendum Trustee Kashman seconded. 4 in favor, 1 absent, motion carried.

Being there was no further business, Trustee Landers made a motion to close the meeting. Trustee Kashman seconded. 4 in favor, 1 absent, motion carried.
