The Mayor opened the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance.

The Mayor turned over the floor to the Highway commission.

Trustee Kashman stated that Supervisor was given a punch list and some of the items to date have been completed. Due to a covid complication, CDL test had to be rescheduled to first week of December.

More items to be added to the list due to the upcoming winter season.

We are on track with the December Delivery date for the Western Star Truck. They will give us a more updated date when we get closer to completion.

Everything seems to be going ok so far.

Trustee Landers had nothing to add and moved to close the highway commission meeting. Trustee Kashman seconded. Two in favor, one absent, motion carried.

The Mayor reopened the regular board meeting.

Vouchers/Abstracts/Reports

Trustee Landers made a motion to approve the vouchers. Trustee McGunnigle seconded. Four in favor, one absent, motion carried.

Report

Taxes: Village Relevy sent to the county is \$46,589.55 including delinquent water, penalties, and interest.

Town Water Bill relevies sent to the county for collection: \$24,614.20.

Water Dept & Other Report (Kerry):

10/19 Winterized Dibbles Dam and changed locks. Ran Bobcat and Milling Machine with Village of Hunter

10/20 & 10/21 Water Department Training by NYCOM, meter repairs and Turn off water at 28 Spring Street

10/22 Met with Jason from Lamont and Robin regarding Water Grant items to be done, punch list around Arsenic plant. Worked with Town paving and grader patching

10/23 Work with town again, disinfect shop and vehicles due to Covid 19 scare, meet with spectrum for arsenic plant install.

Received covid test 10/24 results received and documented as negative.

10/26 -10/30 Service and disinfect vehicles, clean shop keep catch basins clear, prep vehicles for snow storm. Shut off water at 84 Philadelphia Hill Rd.

Working on inventory for water department parts. Per Mayor, have stock parts in each size for anticipated breaks, repairs, etc. We are waiting on water meter rebuild kits from EJ Prescott. Have used all 30 previously purchased. Chris Goodrich from EJ Prescott looking into seeing if interior module is warrantied as they should not have broken so easily.

Alfano Repair: Multiple calls to trace service line from property owner. Board made call to repair and bill. Original curb box under street or across road, no map on file. New curb box installed and mapped. Gave hours, materials, etc. to clerk. Property owner billed accordingly. Bob Blain from Town of Hunter assisted.

Dig Safe markouts:

Received 12 dig safe requests, completed and reported marked or clear as appropriate. Also requested 2 markouts for jobs the Village needed to do.

Reviewing materials for Water Certification course. Have a call in to NY Rural Water about online classes. Otherwise in person training in spring.

Repaired/Rebuilt/replaced 14 meters after September Reading. New numbers if applicable given to clerk. Waiting on the rest of the rebuild kits to finish rebuilding meters we had to replace.

Gave Curb box and extension to Pat Leach for new Driveway on Main Street. He damaged old one with bulldozer. He will be billed for parts.

Clean Sunview Water Tower Base and Pump Station

Attended meeting with Jason, Joe and Pump Station Company for Sunview Tower rehab and repair.

Manual meter reads as required by office. Appointments for further repairs pending.

Cleaned up Alfano's yard after repair

Met with Spectrum at Arsenic Plant to install service and dialer
