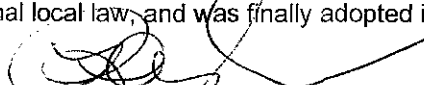

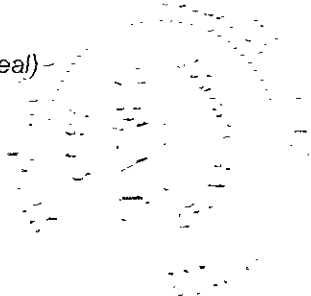

LOCAL LAW # 1 OF 2024
EXPANSION OF MEMBERS OF THE VILLAGE ZONING BOARD OF APPEALS AND
ESTABLISHING ALTERNATE POSITIONS

Be it enacted by the Village Board of the Village of Tannersville

Article I. Title and Purpose

A. Title

This local law shall be known and may be cited as “The Expansion of the Village Zoning Board Of Appeals Membership and Establishing Alternate Members Law” of the Village of Tannersville, New York.

B. Enacting Clause

The Village Board of the Village of Tannersville in the County of Greene, pursuant to the Municipal Home Rule Law, hereby ordains, enacts, and publishes this law.

Article II. Expansion of the Village Zoning Board of Appeals Membership

The number of members of the Village Zoning Board of Appeals of the Village of Tannersville shall be and hereby is expanded from three (3) members to five (5). The two new members shall initially be appointed to a four (4) and a (5) year term respectively. Hereafter, any future appointments, whether being existing members or new members shall be appointed to five (5) year terms.

Article III. Alternate Members

This local law is also specifically enacted to provide a process for appointing “alternate” members to its Zoning Board of Appeals. These individuals would serve when members are absent or unable to participate for any reason on an application or matter before the Zoning Board of Appeals. Alternate members of the Zoning Board of Appeals may be appointed by the Village Board for a term of 1 (one) year. All provisions of state law relating to zoning board of appeals member eligibility, vacancy in office, removal, compatibility of office and service on other boards, as well as any provisions of a local law/local ordinance relating to training, continuing education, compensation and attendance, shall also apply to alternate members.

Article IV. Miscellaneous

- A. This Local Law is expressly adopted pursuant to the relevant sections of the New York State Village Law and the New York State Municipal Home Rule Law.
- B. In the event any section or provision of the laws contained herein or as amended hereafter shall be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the laws as a whole or any part thereof other than the part so declared to be invalid.
- C. This local law shall be effective immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State.
